Paper/Symposium/Poster Guidelines

Papers and Symposia: Presenters should allocate time judiciously among individual papers within a symposia to fit the time listed in their program. Generally, individuals will have about 15 minutes to present their papers, but individual times should be adjusted to allow for the number of presenters and in the case of a discussant. Presenters should allot 5 minutes at the end of the session for audience questions and discussion. Please contact your fellow presenters to determine time allotted for each speaker and to nominate a time keeper.

Posters: Posters will be hung on the wall (tape will be provided), so there is flexibility in poster size. It is recommended that posters remain less than 3.5x6 feet. Presenters should hang their posters prior to the start of the poster session time (see assigned time in the conference program) to facilitate a longer viewing window for conference attendees. Poster sessions are arranged by themes. As such, authors with multiple posters at one session have been arranged so that their posters are next to each other. We hope the themed poster sessions will help to stimulate discussion and thinking among poster authors and attendees.

Reception and Undergraduate Poster Session: On Friday evening we are combining our reception and undergraduate poster session with an Hor d'Oeuvres buffet and cash bar. If you bring a non-registered guest, please buy a ticket (\$10) through the EventBrite website if they would like to enjoy Hor d'Oeuvres. Undergraduate and Graduate Awards will be announced at the reception.
